Start from corner of Garnet Road and Warwick Avenue, Westmere

- I. Continue south along Garnet Road.
- 2. Turn left < into Larchwood Avenue.
- 3. Turn right > into Wellpark Reserve.
- 4. Take the left < fork, then left < again to cross the bridge.
- 5. Enter Maxwell Avenue.
- 6. Turn left < into Warnock Street and follow around the bend to the left < and then immediately right >.
- 7. Turn left < into Dorset Street.
- 8. Cross over Garnet Road and enter Notley Street.
- 9. Turn right > into the walkway between #31 & #33.
- 10. Turn right > onto pathway thru Jaggers Bush Reserve, and then take the next right >.
- 11. Continue straight ahead to Meola Road.
- 12. Cross Meola Road and enter Lemington Reserve, continue straight ahead.
- 13. Turn left < into Lemington Road.
- 14. Turn right > into Westmere Park Road.
- 15. Enter Westmere Park and head to the right-hand corner and the waterfront.
- 16. Turn right > into the small roadway.
- 17. Turn left < into Tirotai Crescent.
- 18. Turn left < into Lemington Crescent.
- 19. Turn left < into Garnet Road, walk to the end and then turn around and return along Garnet Road to the start

Description: Bush track, steps, inclines. Muddy in places when wet. Suitable for users of average fitness and mobility.



A renovation of the existing walkway through Jaggers Bush was completed by City Parks Services in August 2010. It follows a stream through native bush. This route is along quiet suburban streets and links up the Wellpark and Jaggers Bush Reserves, with views along the harbour edge.
