Start from Corner of Queen Street and Clarence Road (Bridgeway Cinema).

- I. Turn into Clarence Road.
- 2. Turn left < along walkway between #48 and #56.
- 3. Turn left < into Council Terrace.
- Turn left < into Church Street.
- 5. Turn right > into Faulkners Road.
- 6. Turn right > into Queen Street.
- 7. Turn left < into Belle Vue Avenue.
- 8. Turn right > into Richmond Avenue.
- 9. Turn left < onto walkway into Stafford Park.
- 10. Continue straight ahead along Denby Lane.
- 11. Cross Stafford Road and then turn left <.
- 12. Turn right > onto walkway beside #25.
- 13. Turn right > into Alfred Street.
- 14. Turn left < into Tennyson Street.
- 15. Turn next right > into Alfred Street
- 16. Turn left < into Tennyson Street</p>
- 17. At corner of Sulphur Beach Road enter the tunnel under the motorway straight ahead.
- 18. On other side, follow the path alongside the motorway heading south.
- 19. Walk under the Harbour Bridge and turn right > into Sulphur Beach Road.
- 20. Turn left < into Beach Road.
- 21. Take next left < into Princes Street.
- 22. Opposite Alma Street (take a short diversion down the hill for a city and bridge foundations view).

- 23. Continue straight ahead down Princes Street.
- 24. Follow the footpath as it goes underneath the motorway to the end (on the far left is a city view) turn right > at end.
- 25. Follow the small pathway that goes down the hill.
- 26. At the bottom of steps turn right > and follow the footpath along Queen Street (if you would like another city view turn left < and walk along the jetty).
- 27. At the roundabout go straight ahead along Queen Street to return to the start.


