Starting from the Carpark (by The Pumphouse off Killarney Street):

I. Walk in front of the Pumphouse and the Rendevous Café along the path up the slope to Killarney Street.

- 2. Turn right > into Killarney Street.
- 3. Turn right > into Lake Pupuke Drive.
- 4. Turn left < into Rangitira Ave.
- 5. Turn right > into Taharoto Road.
- 6. Turn right > into Northcote Road, follow road to the end to the edge of the lake, turn left < along the grassy causeway by the rowing club.
- 7. Turn left < into Shea Terrace.
- 8. Take next right > opposite North Shore Racquet Club, continue straight ahead past the Emergency along North Shore Hospital Road.
- 9. Turn right > Shakespeare Road.
- 10. Continue along Shakespeare Road until you turn right > into Fenwick Avenue. (or turn right > and cut through Milford School to the Milford School Waterwise Centre then follow the path/boardwalk alongside the Lake to the left <).</p>
- II. At the bottom of Fenwick Avenue turn left < to join the lake edge footpath/boardwalk.
- 12. At the T-junction beside the tennis court, turn right >.
- I3. At the T-junction at the bottom of the steps turn left < to continue to circuit (or have a break on the seat to the right >).
- 14. Walk in front of the building 'New Dawn Partnership' and follow the main track veering to the right > diagonally down towards the lake.
- 15. Go through the gate from Sylvan Park and follow the track around edge of lake. (This is closed during the breeding season alternative route is to join Sylvan Park Ave and turn right > into Kitchener Road).
- 16. Exit lake edge at Henderson Park and turn right > into Kitchener Road. (Note the 'castle' at #253/255)
- 17.Turn right > into The Promenade which then becomes Manurere Road and return to the Pumphouse carpark.



Lake Pupuke, Takapuna

Description: A mix of level paths and steep paths/steps. Suitable for users of average fitness and mobility. May require boots in wet weather, running shoes suitable in dry weather. Caution: Muddy and slippery when wet.

To see: Lake activities, water birds
