

Start from the corner of Main Street and Westgate Drive (near the banks).

1. Follow the footpath around to the left > along Westgate Drive to the pedestrian crossing refuge.
2. Cross Westgate Drive at the pedestrian refuge, and turn right > along the footpath alongside the reserve.
3. Turn left < at the path leading into the reserve just before the power tower..
4. Continue straight ahead at the cross paths..
5. Turn left < and cross the bridge, continue straight ahead and cross next bridge.
6. Turn left < at next fork.
7. Turn left < into Cinnabar Place, and follow the footpath.
8. Cross over Rush Creek Road and walk into the Reserve along the gravel path.
9. Keep following the path straight ahead alongside Royal Reserve.
10. Turn right > at the T-junction at the top of the hill.
11. Exit into Beauchamp Drive, turn left < up the hill.
12. Turn left < into Royal Road.
13. Turn left < Westgate Drive, keep to the path on the right hand side of the road and go straight ahead.
14. Turn right > beside the yellow pedestrian bridge and follow the loop path towards the motorway and around the pond.
15. Turn right > back into Westgate Drive and return to Main Street.
