

Starting from the end of Main Street near the banks:

1. Follow the footpath around to the right >.
2. At Westgate Chambers on your right, cross over Westgate Drive and enter the Reserve
3. At the crossroads go straight ahead, keeping to the left.
4. Turn left < and cross the bridge, continue straight ahead and cross next bridge
5. Turn left < at next fork
6. At the Cinnabar Place, turn left < along the footpath
7. Cross over Rush Creek Road and walk into the Reserve along the gravel path
8. Keep following the path straight ahead alongside the reserve
9. At the top of the hill, take the path to the right >
10. Exit into Beauchamp Drive, turn left < up the hill.
11. Turn left < into Royal Road.
12. Turn left < Westgate Drive, keep to the path and go straight ahead.
13. At the seats turn right > and follow the path towards the motorway and around the pond
14. Turn right > back into Westgate Drive and return to Main Street
