#### **Starting from Worcester Road entrance:**

- I. Enter the Reserve at the sign-post and follow the path straight ahead.
- 2. Ignore paths on left; continue straight ahead to St Johns Road
- 3. Exit at St John's Road and turn left <
- 5. Turn left < into Gowing Drive (sign-post to St John's Bush)
- 6. Turn left < into Monkton Place to re-enter St John's Bush
- 7. Turn right > to Worcester Road
- 8. Take the next right > to Worcester Road, across the bridge and up the steps
- 9. Take the next right > up the hill back to Worcester Road







### St Johns Bush

**Description:** A mix of level paths and steep paths/steps. Suitable for users of average fitness and mobility. May require boots in wet weather, running shoes suitable in dry weather. Caution: Muddy and slippery when wet.

**To see**: Nature walk—Flora and fauna, native trees, ferns, stream.

Time: approx. 30 minutes.

**Parking:** Worcester Rd, Meadowbank (off Ipswich Place off St Johns Rd)
