Cornwall Park & One Tree Hill Loop

Description: A mix of mainly level paths, and a few steep paths. Suitable for users of all ages and abilities, suitable for normal footwear and for wheelchairs and pushchairs.

To see: City views, harbour views, trees, Volcano, farm animals, observatory. The Park is home to many birds ranging from Native Pigeon, Fantail to California Quail, White-faced Heron and Paradise Shelduck.

Time: approx. 60 minutes (about 5.3kms)

Parking: Golf, Ngaroma, Empire or Orakau Roads.

Buses: to Manukau Road, Greenwoods Corner

Starting from the ASB Bank, Greenwoods Corner

- I. Cross over Manukau Road at the traffic lights and turn left < heading north along Manukau Road
- 2. Turn right > into Golf Road
- 3. Enter the park through the gate and turn right > at the T-junction
- 4. Continue straight ahead along the footpath beside the Olive Grove
- 5. Cross over to the left-hand side path at Acacia Cottage (opposite the Information Kiosk)
- 6. Follow the footpath around to the left < past the large Pohutukawa tree, continue straight ahead down the path
- 7. Stay on the path, left of the BBQ/Toilets/carpark area
- 8. Take the path to the right > (after the carpark) at the next fork (cherry trees in blossom during October)
- 9. Turn left < at the next junction and follow the wire fence
- 10. At the top of the steps, cross Pohutukawa Drive at the pedestrian crossing
- II. Take the right fork > and continue straight ahead and then the next fork to the right > and right > again, towards the bandstand
- 12. Turn right > around the bandstand, take the second exit path to the right >
- 13. Cross the main path and then take the right > fork (spring magnolia blossoms)
- 14. Turn right > at the Maori Talisman of the Rongo God of the Kumara
- 15. At the end of the path continue straight ahead through the carpark towards Twin Oak Drive
- 16. Cross Twin Oak Drive at the pedestrian crossing, turn left < onto the footpath up the middle of the Drive (map of Cornwall Park Tree Trail here)
- At the end of the path, cross the Drive and turn left < along the footpath (Bollard Ave)
- 18. At the T-junction, cross over and turn left < and follow the path down the hill as it curves to the right
- (Optional: Turn right > to walk to the summit of One Tree Hill and/or to return to Greenwoods Corner via Golf Road)
- Turn right > at the children's playground and follow the path to exit into Manukau Road
- 21. Turn right > into Manukau Road to return to Greenwoods Corner.
