Time: approx. 45 minutes. (about 4.05 kms)

**Start: The University of Auckland, Epsom Campus
(Building A, Epsom Avenue Gate 3)**

1. From Building A turn right > towards Building L and continue around path to Ranfurly Road West
2. Continue down Ranfurly Road, cross Gillies Avenue, cross Manukau Road
3. Turn right > at Market Road, cross Market Road and turn into Wapiti Avenue
4. At the crossroads, turn right > into Wheturangi Road, then turn right > down the track leading into Cornwall Park playing fields.
5. Follow the track across the field.
6. Turn right > into Puriri Drive, cross Campbell Crescent and head to the Sir John Logan Campbell statue and fountain
7. Cross Manukau Road and turn right > along Manukau Road
8. Turn left < into Kimberley Avenue
9. Cross Gillies Avenue and enter Melville Park
10. Continue around Melville Park along the right-hand side
11. Exit Melville Park, turn right > into Saint Andrews Road
12. Follow the pathways to return to the start

Note: Please take care crossing main roads and use safety crossings where available.
