Start: Entrance, The University of Auckland, Grafton Campus (Building 505 Park Road)

- I. Turn right > along Park Road and continue straight ahead
- 2. Cross over Kyhber Pass Road and continue straight ahead
- 3. Cross over Mountain Road at Auckland Grammar School and continue along Mountain Road
- 4. Turn left < into Gilgit Road
- Turn left < into Almorah Road (it looks like a private road with stone fences on either side)
- Turn right into Turn right > into Maungawhau Road (walk under the motorway)
- 7. Turn right > into Seccombes Road
- 8. Turn left < into Crowhurst Street, then cross over into Teed Street
- 9. Turn left < into Osborne Street
- 10. Turn right > into Khyber Pass Road
- Cross over Khyber Pass Road at the lights, turn left < briefly on the other side, then right > along Lumsden Green into Davis Crescent
- 12. Cross over Carlton Gore Road, and turn left < along Carlton Gore Road
- Enter Auckland Domain at "Gum Tree Hill" and turn left < along Grandstand Road
- Continue past the Grandstand, then turn left < up the hill to the corner of Domain Drive and Park Road
- 15. Return to the start



This diverse walk explores the back streets of Newmarket, and gives you a refreshing short break in the Auckland Domain.
