## Eastview Reserve Loop

**Description:** Mostly level paths. Suitable for users of average fitness and mobility.

**To see:** Refresh and revive in Taniwha and Eastview Reserves.

**Time:** approx. 45 minutes. (about 4.0 kms)

**Start: The University of Auckland, Tamaki Campus  
(Building 710.1, Morrin Road Gate 2A)**

1. Take the path between buildings 730 and 721/731.
2. Turn left < into Gate 1 driveway
3. Exit to the right > into Morrin Road
4. Turn left < into Merton Road, cross over Merton Road and continue towards the railway bridge
5. Just before the railway bridge, turn left < onto the path leading to Glen Innes Train Station
6. Continue along the train platform to the other end, either exit right from the tunnel or cross the railway line to the right >.
7. Turn left < into Apirana Avenue
8. Cross Apirana Avenue and turn into Taniwha Street, continue down Taniwha Street
9. Cross Line Road and turn left < into Taniwha Reserve (behind bus shelters)
10. Follow pathway straight ahead through Taniwha Reserve
11. Exit Taniwha Reserve, cross over Line Road, and enter Eastview Reserve (entrance opposite). Follow pathway straight ahead.
12. Exit Eastview Reserve and turn left < into Apirana Avenue
13. Enter the underpass at Glen Innes Train Station and continue straight ahead to exit into Felton Matthew Avenue
14. Cross over Felton Matthew Avenue and turn left <
15. Turn right > into Morton Road
16. Cross over Morton Road to enter Colin Maiden Park (entrance opposite Howard Hunter Avenue)
17. Continue straight ahead past the buildings
18. Turn left < at the carpark
19. Exit left < into Morrin Road and return to the start



**Note: Please take care crossing main roads and use safety crossings where available.**
