Auckland Domain Loop

Description: A mix of level paths, and slightly inclined paths. Suitable for users of average fitness and mobility. May be muddy after rain.

To see: Native bush, parkland, duck pond

Time: approx. 45 minutes. (about 3.86 kms)

Start: Entrance, The University of Auckland, Grafton Campus

(Building 505 Park Road)

1. Cross Park Road to the entrance to Auckland Domain. Follow the footpath on the right hand side of Domain Drive.
2. Take the path to the right > just before the duck pond, and follow the path around beside the pond, past the kiosk and into the carpark
3. Turn right > into The Crescent and continue straight ahead around The Crescent
4. Turn right > into Domain Drive, continue until you almost reach Titoki Street
5. Cross over Domain Drive and enter 'Forest Walks'
6. Follow the track, keeping to the right > 'Domain Walk' at the first junction
7. Turn left < 'Stanley Street' at the next junction
8. Turn left < 'Domain Walk' at the T-junction, then the very next right >
9. Exit to the right > into Lower Domain Drive
10. Cross Lower Domain Drive and enter The Glades Walk (to Duck Pond)
11. Turn right > at the T-junction (to Duck Pond) and follow Lovers Walk following the stream
12. Exit to the right > into Domain Drive
13. Follow Domain Drive back to Park Road and the start



This walk will help you forget that you live and/or work in a city - it takes you into the native bush of the Auckland Domain for a refreshing break, where you can get off the concrete and hear the birds.
