

Starting from the National Bank (Blockhouse Bay Road):

1. Cross over Blockhouse Bay Road at the pedestrian crossing.
2. Turn right > and head south down Blockhouse Bay Road
3. Turn left < into Gittos Domain and continue straight ahead
4. Turn right > at the crossroads (signs to Blockhouse Bay shops, Flounder Bay, Lewis St).
5. At top of the steps, continue straight ahead in front of the seat to steps down on other side
6. Turn right > at the next crossroads in between the seat and the rubbish bin
7. Turn left < at next junction signposted 'Blockhouse Bay Shops' (or if low-tide turn right > and you can walk along shore line to the bottom of Lewis Street)
8. Turn right > at next junction towards Blockhouse Bay Shops and Flounder Bay
9. Turn right > at the T-junction to Lewis Street and Flounder Bay
10. Enjoy the water view before turning left < up Lewis Street.
11. Re-enter Gittos Domain on the left < towards the top of Lewis Street
12. At the junction of steep downward steps, take the path to the left, at the bottom cross the bridge.
13. At the T-junction, turn right >
14. Return to the bank either via Countdown supermarket or the school.
