

Starting from Newmarket Railway Station:

1. Turn right > to exit railway station to Broadway via the open square
2. Cross Broadway and continue straight ahead into Teed Street
3. Turn left < into Gillies Avenue and immediately cross Gillies Avenue at the pedestrian lights
4. Turn right > into Seccombes Road
5. Turn right > into Mountain Road and cross immediately at the pedestrian lights, then turn left < up Mountain Road
6. Turn right > into Clive Road
7. At the bend, cross Clive Road and continue up the road that is closed to vehicles and enter Mount Eden Domain
8. At the roundabout, take the first turn to the left < into Puhī Huia Road to the summit
9. At the end of the tar-sealed path, stay on the dirt track
10. At the end of the dirt track, take the steps to the right > and continue along the gravel track
11. At the end of the gravel track, take the steps to the left < (look behind for a view)
12. Turn left < T-junction at the top of the crater
13. Follow the path around the rim of the crater, turn left < at the road T-junction
14. Turn right > at the steps and track on the other side of the fence
15. Exit at the fence into Batger Street
16. Turn left < into Mount Eden Road
17. Turn left into Stokes Road, and continue along Owens Road
18. Turn left < into Mountain Road (Eden Gardens at end of Omana Avenue)
19. At the gates of Government House, turn right > into Withiel Drive (Mount Hobson straight ahead)
20. Turn left < into Gillies Avenue
21. Cross Gillies Avenue and Alpers Avenue at the traffic lights and continue straight ahead along Gillies Avenue
22. Cross Mortimer Pass and turn right > on the other side down Mortimer Pass (entrance to Highwic House)
23. Cross Broadway at the traffic lights and continue straight ahead along Balm Street
24. Turn left < into Nuffield Street
25. Cross Remuera Road at the traffic lights at the end of Nuffield Street, and turn right > to return to Newmarket Railway Station.
